This joint degree can possibly be combined under the double degree agreement with the degree awarded by the Université de Lille (Frankrijk) and/or the Rijksuniversiteit Groningen (*University of Groningen*, Nederland) in due compliance with article II.172§2 of said code.

The curriculum of this programme amounts to 120 credits.
