

**Resolution no. 15/2022
of the Senate of the Medical University of Gdańsk
dated 28 February 2022**

Declaration of solidarity with Ukraine

Pursuant to § 17 sect. 5 of the MUG Statute dated 3 June 2019 (namely, App. no. 1 to the Resolution no. 20/2021 of the MUG Senate dated 26 April 2021)

it is now resolved, as follows:

§ 1

Senate of the Medical University of Gdańsk strongly condemns Russia's unlawful military aggression against Ukraine that represents an unprecedented in 21st century Europe, unacceptable violence act against an independent country and its residents. The Senate of the Medical University of Gdańsk expresses solidarity with out students, doctoral students and employees from Ukraine in this difficult moment of fight for the preservation of their sovereignty and integrity of their country. We would like to assure your of our readiness to support and assistance for students, doctoral students and employees of Ukrainian universities.

This call is also a declaration of participation in all programs of Polish National Agency For Academic Exchange (NAWA) that will be made in order to support Ukrainian citizens who study and work in Poland. The current, perennial and good cooperation with academic communities in Ukraine shall be continued, as shall continue the presence of Ukrainian students, doctoral students and employees in our academic community. We are bound by mutual European values such us freedom, equality and justice.

This resolution comes into effect on the day of its enacting.
